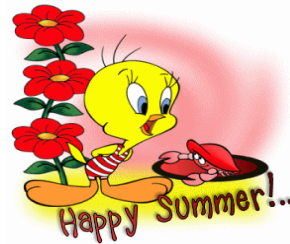
Tidbit from X-JWC Past 50 years

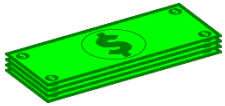
