They request that a check be cut and money sent to a specific account; or they request that funds be transferred electronically to a specific account.

Please verify directly with the purpose presenting the request. Organizations including Western States Region have been scammed in this manner. The result for WSR was that the checking account had to be closed and a new one opened. Luckily the bank was told and the perpetrators were not able to cash the check.
